
Family Activity - Playdough Hearts (you need some play dough for everyone)

Give everyone in your family about 1/4 cup of play dough. Have everyone roll the play dough into a ball. With the ball of play dough sitting in the palm of your hand, tell it to change into a heart. Nothing happens, does it! Now, using just the fingers on the hand holding the play dough, try to shape the ball into a heart. What happened? Could you do it? Now use the fingers of the other hand to shape the ball into a heart. Did it work? Just like the play dough, we can't change all by ourselves. We need the Holy Spirit to change our hearts to be more like Jesus. Jesus loves everyone!




God is perfect. He can't be around sin. He can't ignore the wrong things you do. Your sin hurts God and hurts others.
