Population Numbers:


U.S.A. - 328,000,000 people

# Family Activity - Commandment Charades

You can help the rest of your family learn the Ten Commandments by playing a game of charades. First, write out each commandment on a separate piece of paper. Put the folded pieces of paper in a bowl or hat or bag and then draw one out and act it out for your family. See if they can guess the correct commandment. Whoever guesses the correct commandment takes the next turn acting out a commandment. Play until all the pieces of paper have been drawn from the bowl. Re mind your family that commandments 1-4 are about our relationship with God and commandments 5-10 are about relationships with people.

If you do choose to sin, it makes God sad. It keeps you from talking to Him the way you should. As soon as you know you have sinned, tell God about it. Admit that you were wrong. Ask God to help you stop doing the wrong thing.
